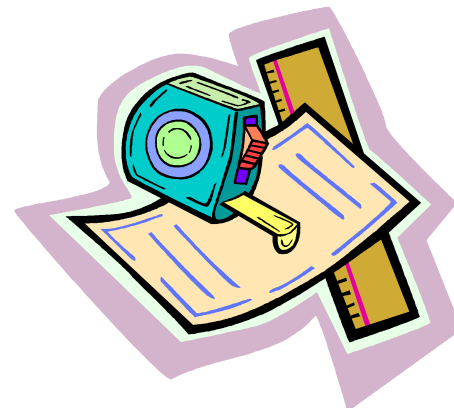


Tracking the Politicians
